Case Study: St. Charles High School

Overview

Background

- Brady Lake, an educator at St. Charles High School, was trained in EBLI and delivered instruction to all Juniors to test the impact of EBLI's Secondary Vocabulary curriculum for college readiness.
- Brady delivered EBLI instruction in a whole class setting.
- St. Charles High School used the American College Testing (ACT) scores to assess student progress and the effectiveness of EBLI instruction.

About the Study

- St. Charles High School compared school-wide ACT Reading and Composite scores in 2010 (no EBLI instruction) to 2011 ACT Reading and Composite scores (with EBLI instruction).
- From the January until the ACT test the beginning of March, students received just over 1 hour of EBLI instruction per week for 8 weeks for a total of 9 to 10 hours of instruction.
- Students were encouraged to read natural text beyond direct EBLI instruction to enhance the learning process.

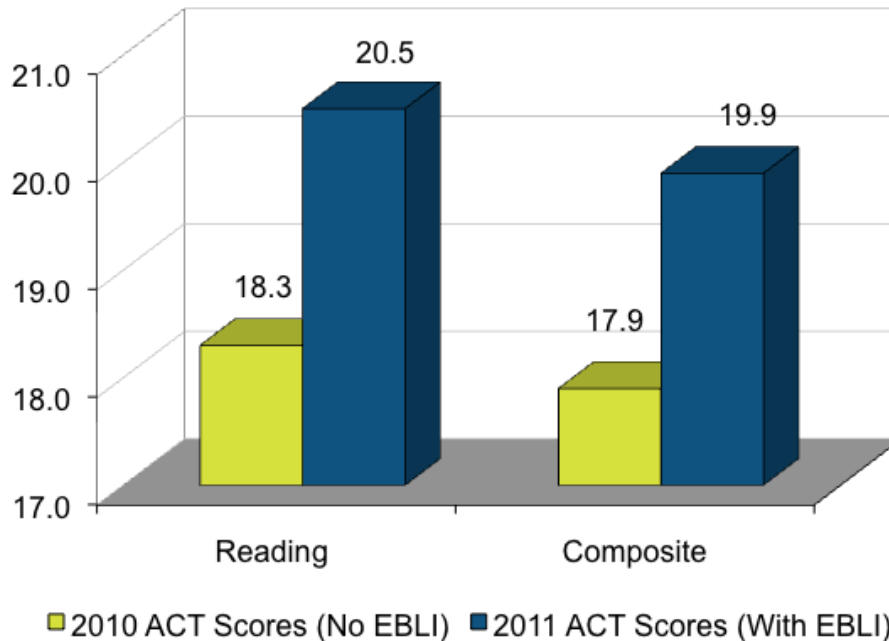
