



On-site EBLI Trainings

Can I host an EBLI training at my location?

Yes. EBLI staff will travel for a maximum of 1 on-site training per month on a first come, first served basis.

What are the requirements?

- There must be a minimum of 14 new trainees from hosting school/district.
- 50% of total training tuition (not including coaching) must be paid at time of booking to secure training date.
- Hosting school/district is responsible for paying all travel expenses the EBLI staff incurs, including mileage, hotel, and meals.
- Must open training to “outside” districts and organizations (up to 40 people).
- Must provide water, coffee, tea, and mid-morning snacks to trainees all 3 days. This includes trainees from outside districts and organizations.
- Trainees from hosting school/district should be required to read *Why Our Children Can't Read* by Diane McGuinness and *The Teacher Who Couldn't Read* by John Corcoran prior to training.
- Trainees from hosting school/district must visit at least one other school and observe an EBLI lesson prior to being trained. EBLI will work with Administrator of hosting school/district to determine which school is the best fit for a visit.

What kind of room set-up is required?

- There must be long rectangular tables (no circle or square tables) so that trainees can easily work with their neighbors during practice.
- Room must comfortably hold up to 40 people.
- A wireless internet connection and password are required.
- Must have a large whiteboard to project on (minimum of 4 x 4 feet).

***Please Note: Trainees are responsible for their own breakfast and lunch. Please make a list of nearby restaurants for trainees from outside districts and organizations.*
