In English, 1, 2, 3, or 4 letters can spell a sound. EX:

high
eight

In English, the same sound can be spelled in many different ways. EX:

In English, the same letter(s) can represent many different sounds.
EX:
on
$\frac{\mathrm{O}}{\mathrm{no}}$
$\frac{\mathrm{O}}{\mathrm{do}}$
dog
son

2. aberration
