In English, 1, 2, 3, or 4 letters can spell a sound. EX:

on

she

high

<u>eight</u>

In English, the same sound can be spelled in many different ways. EX:

<u>Z</u> zip

<u>ZZ</u> buzz S is

<u>ze</u> haze

choose

In English, the same letter(s) can represent many different sounds. EX:

<u>o</u> on

<u>o</u> no <u>0</u> do

<u>o</u> dog

<u>o</u> son

In English, a strategy to decode multisyllable words is crucial. EX:

1. cacophony

ca co pho ny

2. aberration

a b<u>err</u> a <u>ti</u>on
