Case Study: Beach Elementary

Overview

Background

- EBLI trained all kindergarten teachers at Beach Elementary School, located in Fruitport, MI.
- Educators were trained in EBLI in June 2006 and taught EBLI in the classroom for the entire 2006/2007 school year.
- All 60 kindergarten students at the school received EBLI instruction.
- Beach Elementary used DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills) as the assessment to measure student progress and the effectiveness of EBLI.

About the Study

- Beach Elementary teachers delivered EBLI instruction in whole class settings.
- Students received EBLI instruction as part of their reading instruction curriculum.
- Beach Elementary recorded DIBELS scores in 2005, 2006, and 2007 for each kindergarten year; the comparison from 2005 (no EBLI instruction) to 2006 (first year of EBLI instruction for all K students) and 2007 (second year of teachers teaching EBLI) showed results from EBLI instruction.

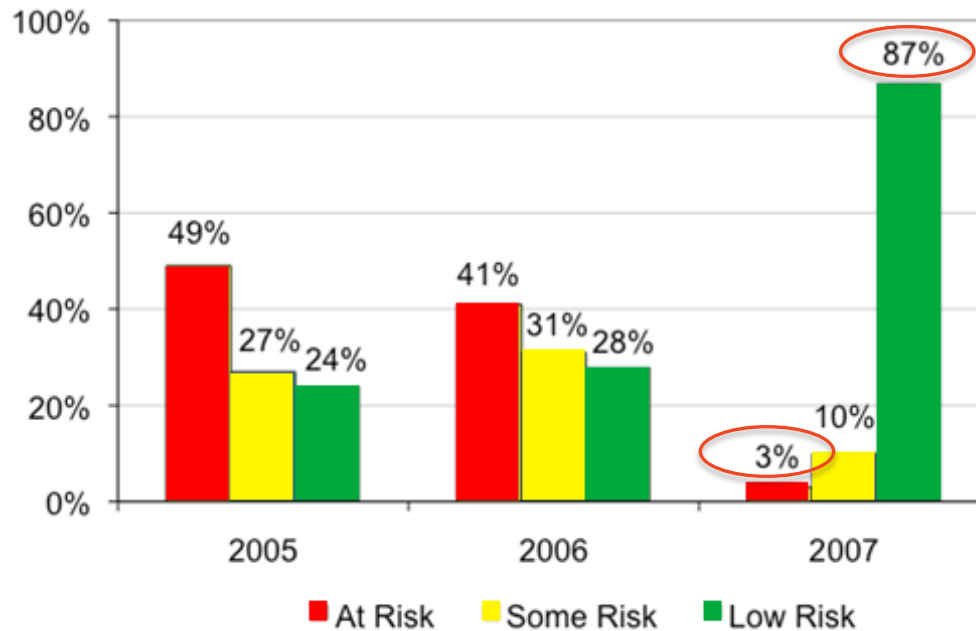

With EBLI Instruction...

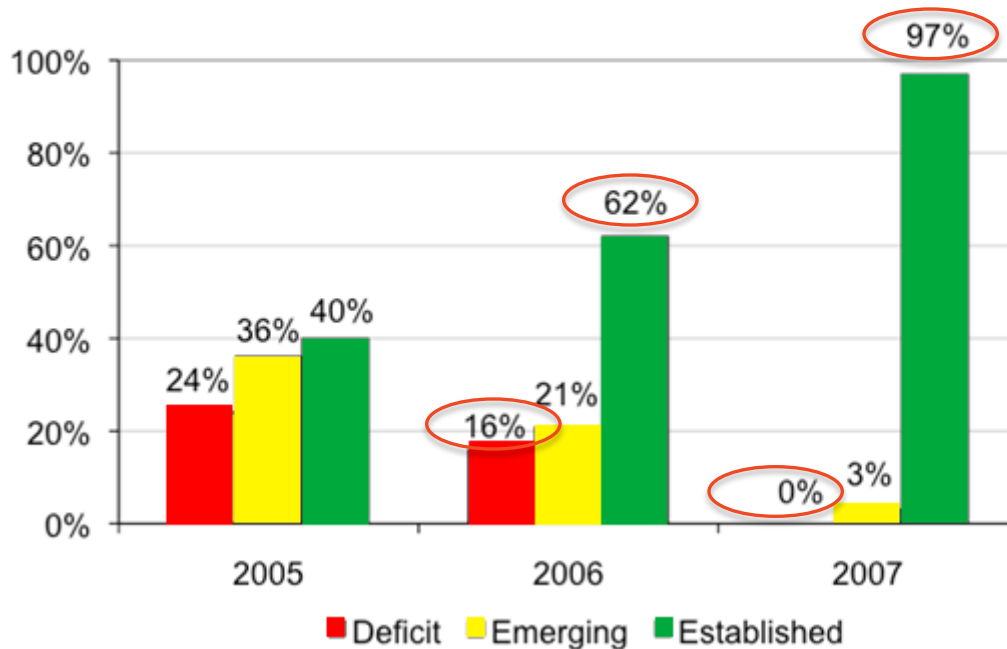
- The % of At Risk students decreased 38%
- The % of Low Risk students increased 59%

With EBLI Instruction...

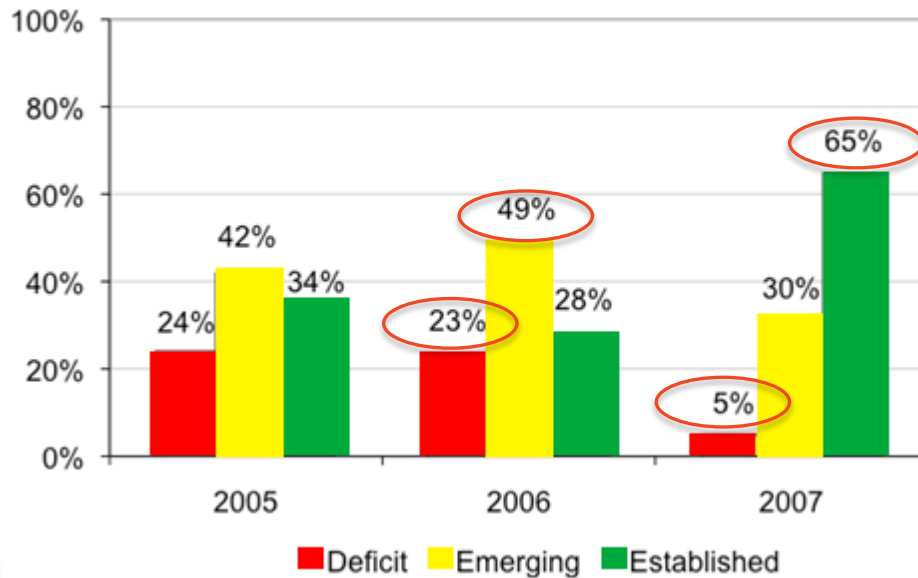
- The % of students at a Deficit decreased 16%
- The % of Established students increased 35%

With EBLI Instruction...

- The % of students at a Deficit decreased 18%
- The % of Established students increased 37%
