



Student Learning

- Video to teach students
 - Whole-Class explicit instruction
 - Small-Group Reading and Differentiated Instruction
 - Teacher facilitates
 - Videos fade over time
 - Teacher takes over instruction
- Materials
 - Included
 - Video instruction transitionally
 - Stories for Small-Group Reading
 - Content Words, Rubrics, Examples
 - For each activity
 - Independent practice worksheets


WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF EBLI?

- Increased positive feedback at parent conferences



Incredible results, even during remote learning!





6th Grade – Individual Intervention



- Woodcock Johnson III


Average grade level of students before/after treatment


